3. PFT workshop proceedings AIIMS Rishikesh, 2nd and 3rd Feb

A two-day academic event "Pulmonary Function Test Workshop" was conducted on 2 & 3 February 2019 by the Department of Pulmonary Medicine, AIIMS Rishikesh under the aegis of Uttarakhand Chapter of Indian Chest Society. The event was attended by 43 participants, which included physicians and technicians.

Day one (02.02.2019) was divided into two sessions: Pre-lunch session comprised of series of didactic lectures on basic and advanced PFTs; post-lunch session comprised of four hands-on workstations on spirometry, diffusion capacity, body box and six-minute walk test. On **day two**, Mr Roberto Perissin (Vice President, Worldwide FOT and Asthma Management Business Development for MGC Diagnostics) took lectures and provided a hands-on demonstration on the equipment for Forced Oscillation Technique (FOT) and Fractional Exhaled Breath Nitric Oxide (FeNO).


Accreditation: The event received four CME credit hours for the Uttarakhand Medical Council.
